- 3. Notice Convening the Meeting

- **6. Community Governance and The Boundary Review:** Cllr Archer reported that she had contacted Diddlebury Parish Council regarding Aston Top. Cllr Motley will raise the issue at the Diddlebury PC meeting.
- 7. Update on the Parish Council's work to reduce the speed of vehicles: Cllr Archer reported that the Parish Council have been in contact with both Shropshire Council and other parishes along the B4368. As a result a route study has been performed and we are awaiting the report. The Speed Watch Team in Munslow has been advised by West Mercia Police that it was too dangerous for them to operate but a new initiative by the police

will be in operation in Munslow soon. A Speed Watch Team for Aston Munslow was planned but the Police were unable to support it as there was not sufficient road engineering in the village. At the last Parish Council meeting it was agreed to support the '20's Plenty For Us' National Campaign.

- **8.** Hear about Plans for a New Defibrillator in the Parish: The Parish Council has been looking into this for a number of years. The most likely site is the telephone box outside The Crown in Munslow. We are in the process of sourcing a defibrillator and an electrician to organise the connection.
